

Right Side of Display Darkens, Becomes Blurry, and Flashes When Anti-Aliasing Is Enabled

This issue affects RADEON products using driver version 4.12.3044 or 4.12.3056 under Windows 98.

In some games, the right side of the display in some games may darken, become blurry, and begin to flash. This effect appears only when anti-aliasing is enabled.



The following programs are currently known to exhibit this symptom:

- Asheron's Call
- KISS: Psycho Circus

Other games may also be affected.

To correct this issue, please obtain and install RADEON Display Driver version 4.12.3063 or higher.

To work around this issue when using the 4.12.3044 or 4.12.3056 driver releases, disable Direct3D anti-aliasing as follows:

1. Open the **DISPLAY PROPERTIES** panel and select the **SETTINGS** tab.
2. Click on the **ADVANCED** button and then select the **Direct 3D** tab.
3. Change the **Anti-aliasing** option to **DISABLED**.
4. **APPLY** the changes.
